



## DIRECTIONS

### Walking from Leeds Station:

As you come out through the ticket barriers walk directly ahead to the exit by Marks & Spencer Simply Food. As you come outside the station, turn left and walk down the bus/taxi route until you come to the pedestrian crossing at the traffic lights (across the road you will see the Park Plaza Hotel). Cross here and look to your left, ahead of you, you should see the statue of The Black Prince (on horseback), and the large sandstone coloured Victorian building with a clock tower on the roof behind it is Quebecs Luxury Apartments. Walk towards the building and you will find our entrance on Infirmery Street, just past the corner of Banyan on the ground floor (to the right as you look at the building). Quebecs Luxury Apartments has two small trees and 2 large flags outside the entrance.

### By car from M1:

Take Junction 43 of M1 onto M621, take Junction 3, and follow signs for Central Leeds for approximately ½ mile. With Clayton Hotel on your left get into the second lane. At the traffic Lights (with Asda/KPMG on your right) go straight ahead, following signs for 'city centre loop'. Under the arches, again go straight through the traffic lights and get into your right hand lane. Go around city square, Quebecs Luxury Apartments is the sandstone coloured building within the square, onto Quebec Street, and get into the right hand lane. Turn right onto King Street, and then turn right again at 53 North Bar onto Infirmery Street. The road is signed as 'Limited Access Only' but you are permitted to use it to access Quebecs Luxury Apartments. You will find a drop off point on your right hand side outside Quebecs Luxury Apartments just after the traffic lights; one of our guest services agents will then direct you to the nearby Q-Park at Criterion Place (<http://www.q-park.co.uk/parking/leeds/q-park-criterion-place>) or to the Quebecs Luxury Apartments' car park.

### By car from M62 / Manchester:

Take Junction 27, and then on to the M621 take Junction 3, follow signs for Central Leeds for approximately ½ mile. With Clayton Hotel on your left get into the second lane. At the traffic Lights (with Asda/KPMG on your right) go straight ahead, following signs for 'city centre loop'. Under the arches, again go straight through the traffic lights and get into your right hand lane. Go around city square, Quebecs Luxury Apartments is the sandstone coloured building within the square, onto Quebec Street, and get into the right hand lane. Turn right onto King Street, and then turn right again at 53 North Bar onto Infirmery Street. The road is signed as 'Limited Access Only' but you are permitted to use it to access Quebecs Luxury Apartments. You will find a drop off point on your right hand side outside Quebecs Luxury Apartments just after the traffic lights; one of our guest services agents will then direct you to the nearby Q-Park at Criterion Place (<http://www.q-park.co.uk/parking/leeds/q-park-criterion-place>) or to the Quebecs Luxury Apartments' car park.

### By car from M62 / Hull:

Take Junction 29, join M1 North. At Junction 43 turn on to M6212. At Junction 3, follow signs for Central Leeds for approximately ½ mile. With Clayton Hotel on your left get into the second lane. At the traffic Lights (with Asda/KPMG on your right) go straight ahead, following signs for 'city centre loop'. Under the arches, again go straight through the traffic lights and get into your right hand lane. Go around city square, is the sandstone coloured building within the square, onto Quebec Street, and get into the right hand lane. Turn right onto King Street, and then turn right again at 53 North Bar onto Infirmery Street. The road is signed as 'Limited Access Only' but you are permitted to use it to access Quebecs Luxury Apartments. You will find a drop off point on your right hand side outside Quebecs Luxury Apartments; one of our guest services agents will then direct you to the nearby Q-Park at Criterion Place (<http://www.q-park.co.uk/parking/leeds/q-park-criterion-place>) or to the Quebecs Luxury Apartments' car park.
